



Concentrator Shift Supervisor

Perilya Broken Hill Limited own and operate the Southern, North, and Potosi Pb / Zn / Ag mines in Broken Hill NSW. The ore from these mines is processed in the concentrator at Southern Operations to produce Pb and Zn concentrates which are sold to smelters and refineries in Australia and overseas.

The concentrator at Southern Operations utilises a conventional crushing, grinding, and sequential Pb / Zn sulphide mineral flotation flow sheet to produce Pb and Zn concentrates which are filtered and loaded directly into rail wagons on site for transport to Port Pirie. The tailings from the concentrator is classified into a coarse and fine fraction with the coarse fraction used for underground fill and the fine fraction disposed of to the tailings storage facility.

Perilya is currently seeking a Concentrator Shift Supervisor to manage one of the four operating crews to ensure that all of the production requirements are met safely and efficiently.

Responsibilities will include but are not limited to:

- Management and supervision of your team of operators;
- Training, coaching, and mentoring your team of operators;
- Contributing to achieving a safe work place;
- Contributing to avoiding any impact to the environment;
- Achieving the operations production targets;
- Liaising with the maintenance department and supervising maintenance activities on the back shifts;
- Liaising with the mining department;
- Liaising with outside contractors, including the rail service provider.

To be successful in this role you will have:

- A minimum 5 years experience as an operator in a mineral processing plant
- Experience in a supervisory role in a mineral processing plant
- An understanding of leadership as it applies to a supervisory role
- A commitment to safety in the work place
