On the Broken Hill "Line of Lode", Perilya currently operates 3, zinc-lead-silver mines in Broken Hill, the Potosi Mine, North Mine and Southern Operations, holds a number of exploration tenements and has development approval for an open pit mine, the Flying Doctor.

Perilya directly employs 440 workers and indirectly 200 full time equivalent contractors on its sites and provides ongoing work for a number of local, industry supporting, businesses.

The Role

Reporting to the Environmental Superintendent, the Environment Advisor will be responsible for supporting the environmental management activities of the Perilya Broken Hill Operations.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Operating environmental monitoring processes as required, enabling safe operations in the process. This includes regular and thorough environmental audits.
- Identifying critical risks to the environmental security of the operations and allowing for contingency.
- Undertaking designated improvement projects
- Ensuring all relevant documentation is completed in a timely and efficient manner and to the agreed standard.
- Compliance with all safety and environmental requirements.
- Ensuring internal policies and operating practices are effectively communicated and adhered to.
- Reporting all environmental incidents, completing quality investigations to prevent recurrence.
- Maintaining a close working relationship with all departments within the business.

What you need to succeed

To be successful in this role you will have a tertiary qualification in Environmental Engineering, Environmental Science or equivalent, a minimum of two years mine site experience and a demonstrated ongoing commitment to safe work practices. Required for the role is a current Australian driver's license.
