

# Mine Planning Superintendent



Perilya is currently seeking a Mine Planning Superintendent. Reporting to the Technical Services Manager, the purpose of this role is to ensure timely delivery of mine planning processes to meet the annual mining plan. This position is also heavily involved in the Life of Mine Planning process and Ore Reserve publication. You will be assisted by a team of professionals who will look to you for task assignment, guidance and support.

Key responsibilities will include:

- Providing mine planning and scheduling services to meet mine department plans and budgets
- Ensuring that designs are practical, economical and address all relevant standards
- Ensuring that ventilation meets statutory requirements
- Providing leadership that ensures all work supports safe operation
- Establishing suitable processes for the identification of strategic and tactical operating options
- Ensuring your team understands the work plan and prioritises, and they have the skills and knowledge necessary to provide the required level of planning for the operation
- Providing guidance to the team when managing various technical aspects across the operation

To be successful in this role you will have a tertiary qualification in Mining Engineering accompanied by considerable exposure to underground mining with an understanding of technical and operating processes. It is expected you will have extensive technical, scheduling and planning experience. You must be able to demonstrate leadership success with prior supervisory/management experience. Remnant mining experience will be highly valued. Open pit experience will be advantageous but not essential.

Essential to the position is an understanding of all key processes that impact upon mining operations. Excellent written and verbal communication skills will be required along with a high degree of computer literacy skills. Experience with Vulcan, Studio 5d, Ventsim, EPS, Aegis and MSO is desirable. Spanish language skills while not essential will be advantageous.

This is a **residential** role that includes an attractive remuneration package including base salary, superannuation, company housing and private health cover.
