

Mining Manager- Northern Operations

The position is for the Mine Manager of Perilya Broken Hill's Potosi Operations and North Mine (Northern Operations). Potosi produces 39-40kt/month and currently has a life of mine (LOM) to 2021 with an active exploration program looking to extend LOM beyond this. North Mine is predominantly a remnant mining operation scheduled to ramp to producing 25-30kt/month, the current LOM is out to 2030. The two operations produce high grade zinc, lead, silver ore that is transported to and processed at Perilya's Southern Operations.

Reporting to the Deputy General Manager the purpose of this role is to control and oversee all aspects of the mining production operation through effectively organising the department's people, resources and assets, while also meeting the safety, environmental, quality and cost objectives of the Company.

The role will include, but not limited to, the following key responsibilities:

- Manage and plan production levels, resource requirements and supporting capital projects for inclusion in Perilya Broken Hill Operations annual Plan.
- Coordinate the development of strategic plans, monitor/evaluate performance and provide business analysis as required.
- Maintain an overview of operational activities and issues through interaction with mining superintendents, supervisors and workers and frequent inspections of the mining operations.
- Lead decision making on issues which may have an immediate operational effect or may influence long term mine production operation activities.
- Manage and monitor costs and identify ways of making them transparent to the workforce.
- Devise and implement safe work procedures, standards and risk management protocols to ensure that risks have been properly assessed and treated and that all work conducted on site complies with Perilya's OHS requirements.
- Manage and monitor the performance and development of individuals within your work group, play a prominent role in motivating, mentoring, coaching and developing team members, and in achieving team cohesion and targets.

To be successful in this role you will have extensive operational experience (functional-mining), excellent communication and leadership skills and demonstrate an ongoing commitment to safe work practices. The candidate will also have a NSW Mining Engineering Manager's Certificate of Competency or equivalent, SafeWork NSW Security Clearance and Five years experience in underground mine operations.

Essential to the position is an understanding of all key processes that impact upon mining operations, including the interaction that occurs between differing parties. Excellent written and verbal communication skills are crucial along with high computer literacy skills.

This is a residential role that includes an attractive remuneration package including base salary and superannuation, private health cover and housing benefits.
